Violations of authorial integrity, including plagiarism, invasion of privacy, unauthorised access, and trade secret and copyright violations, may be grounds for sanctions against members of Ama Training Group whanau, this includes staff and students.

Procedure

If a breach of privacy or information is suspected to have occurred this must be reported to the Quality Assurance Manager in the first instance for investigation.
